Its time to get messy with some big creative ideas



Work is showcased via in house exhibitions, the Zinc website, social media and is entered into appropriate awards. Students are also encouraged to develop enterprise and small business skills, through selling their work produced during this course.



Visual arts

A dynamic look at worldwide visual artists and how their work impacts the world around us. Pick up a paint brush and see if you're the next Picasso or grab some clay and get sculpting.



Animation & visual story telling

From flick books to Fantasia, discover the world of animated movie making. Or perhaps you want to join the world of Marvel and DC and explore the comic book style of storytelling. Be your own hero this time.

Artistic work or practice that uses digital technology as part of the creative or presentation process. Graphics, logos, social media and web design all contribute to the most modern of modern arts.

Stepping Stones

Stepping Stones will prepare you for the world of work and offer you an apprenticeship at Zinc Arts, which could lead onto paid employment with local employers, or even Zinc ourselves.

In the past, apprenticeships have been in catering, hospitality, administration, building services, gardening, teaching support, marketing, events management, finance and customer service. What will you do?



Employability

A two hours per week work placement / internship at Zinc or other local employers. These placements can be arranged by Zinc and students will be fully supported.



Community understanding

Gain teamwork skills and build positive relationships in the workplace.



Work Readiness

Preparing for work from mock interviews, how to look for suitable vacancies, CV building and application forms.



Communication skills

Developing personal communication skills using traditional and contemporary methods including email, spoken language, the written word and social media.



Social enterprise

Students will be learning entrepreneurial skills and putting these into practice with their own enterprise groups.

Creating and selling products or services for sale to the external and internal community at Zinc.



First steps

Begin your journey by looking at the world of work and finding your place in it. Prepare for work placements, overcome barriers to work and look at career exploration.

Perform

All aspects of performing arts, focusing on skills you need, both on, and off the stage

Perform is perfect for anyone looking to develop new or existing skills in theatre, acting, dance and music.

Engage in many different performing art forms, from singing to dance, music production, script writing, prop making, directing and theatre technology. Work with professional actors and experienced theatre practitioners. Work with a team of like-minded individuals to create a high quality performance, which will be showcased in our very own Zinc theatre.



Singing

Dancing

Music production

Explore and have fun with different sounds while experimenting with a range of different instruments and analysing a variety of music performances.

Theatre technology

To become more aware of our emotions, thinking, behaviours and physical symptoms.




Social skills

Elevate focuses on the core subjects that are delivered in every educational setting.


Learn functional skills in maths and English. Useful applications for the development of key skills, delivered in a practical, easy to digest, kinesthetic way.

Maybe complete some crazy experiments and fun investigations into the fundamental forces that shape out natural world and broaden your horizons into the wider universe.




Literacy


Numeracy

Functional numeracy skills focusing on quantities, money, time, measurements, data handling, geometry and statistics. Every project needs the numbers to add up. Time to put your thinking cap on.



Science

Exploring the forces of nature, biodiversity, chemical rections and our place in the universe. Put on your safety goggles and lets get experimenting.



Living Dioramas:

A site-specific, performance art, instillation. Students design and create an environment based on a story of their choice. A room in Hogwarts School for example or perhaps a Pokemon battling arena or maybe an alien planet. Who Knows?

Those who want to, will then step inside their environment and bring them to life. Of course there will then be a chance for parents, carers and anyone who wants to, to come along and see the finished product.



Students will be able to collect 4 specific **AQA units** for this project depending upon the roles they chose within the group and the number of days they attend.

Fewer days attendance simply means less time to complete all the required learning objectives.

On top of this students will pick up English skills from writing the script, leadership skills for those who feel confident enough and all the benefits that come from creativity and imagination.



Finance & Support Options

Course Costs

A full term at **Zinc Education** costs £655 for a one day a week placement. Prices are based on a 13 week term, which will run as close as possible to Essex local authority term dates. Please contact us to discuss further payment options.

Students can opt to participate in anywhere between 1-4 days a week Tue-Fri.

With our discount accumulator scheme there is a 5% discount for the 2nd day, 10% for the 3rd and a full 25% off for the 4Th day. In real terms this is the same as paying full price for 3 days and receiving the fourth absolutely free!
